WHO ARE WE & WHAT DO WE DO?

Women on Site is a registered nonprofit organization that hosts networking and social events for women and non-binary people in the construction, manufacturing, and building science industries.

While there are efforts by the government, businesses, unions, and educational institutions to recruit more women into our industries, the same cannot be said for the efforts to **keep us once we're in**. Few resources or organizations offer opportunities to build relationships with people who have had similar experiences, challenges, and that familiar feeling of being the "only one" on site.


